



SDG Target 4.7:

By 2030, ensure that all learners acquire knowledge and skills needed to promote sustainable development, including, among others, through education for sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles...

Example (total 100 questions)

- "Is there any eco-plastic in your environment?"
- "Do you provide workshops for kids about waste separation?"
- "Do you offer vegan / plant-based meals at least once a week?"
- "Do you and your personnel engage in any outside (park, garden, etc.) teaching or activities with children?"
- "Do you look after the plants yourself and educate children how to?"
- "Do you work with a local food supplier?"
- "Do you do any charitable work? What charity or social initiatives have you performed or plan to complete? (for example, giving kids cloths a second life and etc.)"
- "Do you educate and talk to your children about the importance of sharing and helping others?"
- "Do you use materials left over for art projects or other permaculture activities?"
